On Sunday October 21st, The Amherst Friends for the Homeless organization is running its annual "Shelter Sunday". This is a special event where volunteers go door-to-door at residences surrounding Amherst center and raise money for several homeless shelters in the local area.

The organizers provide volunteers with maps, envelopes, and instructions on how to ask for donations. Volunteers head out in groups of 4-5 people. Residents of Amherst are aware of Shelter Sunday and will be expecting the donation inquiries. Last year, they raised over \$25,000 in just a few hours of work. Over 300 people volunteered, including over 200 students from UMass.

We are getting together a group to represent Alpha Lambda Delta and help out on Shelter Sunday. The event kicks off at 12:30pm on the Amherst Town Common. We will meet up in front of the Isenberg School of Management at 12pm and then walk into Amherst Center. This event does not run very long, it will be a time committment of a few hours at most.
