

1a) Will = modal, the=Det, man=N, in=P, the=Det, mask=N, rob=V, the=Det, bank=N

1b) Who=N, can=modal, John=N, see=V, with=P, the=Det, binoculars=N

2) the=Det, thief=N, hit=V, man=N, with=P, a=Det, stick=N

4) what=N, was=???, the=Det, man=N, hit=V, with=P

** Note: The word "was" in question (4) is the past tense form of the verb "to be". This is not a "normal" verb, however, but is used in a special construction that we talked about in class...
