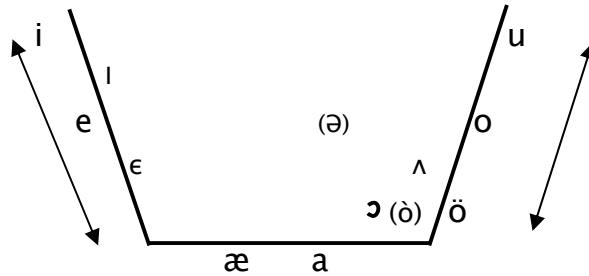

Outside: long vowels
Inside: short vowels

Note: “In . . . Shughni . . . the long vowels are very stable, but the short vowels, in particular *i* and *u* . . . show a tendency to undergo wide allophonic variation.” (Payne 1989: 426)

Examples: “moon” /mæst/, /mɛst/.
“he” /yʌyɛ/, /yoyɛ/.
