

This is my new Ferris FW25 walk behind mower. It has a twin cylinder, 18.5 hp Kawasaki engine; 36" cut. It has electric start and a legitimate reverse gear that actually works. It also has hydrostatic drive, which gives much smoother operation than I had in the Gravely. If you look closely you may be able to see the Gravely stand-up sulky behind the mower. I kept that when I sold the Gravely. My neighbors tell me I look pretty silly driving around on this thing, but I have gotten used to a stand-up sulky. I think it makes for easier maneuvering around trees, stone walls, gravestones, and other obstacles.
