Education 592S - On-site Pre-Practicum

Basis for Waiver Application: Relevant Experience in Schools

There is one basis upon which student may seek to apply for a waiver for this component of the program: supervised teaching experience.

Documentation: This course may be waived if a student provides evidence of teaching middle and high school students for at least one semester. The student must provide a letter from the supervisor of that teaching experience indicating that teaching had been supervised, allowed for reflection, and had been successfully completed.

<u>Limitation:</u> The experience used for applying to waive this pre- practicum may not then be used to waive any other experience in the program.

Note: Candidates in STEP normally student teach at their Pre-Practicum site. Waiving this course can affect your student teaching placement.

Waiving a course meets the requirement of the course but does not render credit for the course. Students in the Master's program will need to substitute an elective for any of the course they have waived if waiving the course will bring them below the number of course credits required for the master's degree.

Submit two copies of the application for a waiver, documentation, and self-addressed, stamped envelope to your faculty advisor.
