**Research Experience (Volunteer)**

Faculty in the Biostatistics and Epidemiology program make every effort to secure funded research assistantships for students. However, it may not be possible to fund all students. From time to time, students have expressed an interest in gaining research experience, even if it is without pay. If a student is interested in gaining research experience without pay, this document describes the procedure.

Students wishing to gain research experience may 'volunteer' for such research experience. Such experience will usually involve a 5 hour per week time commitment, arranged with the Faculty sponsor. If you are interested, talk with individual faculty to see if such a research experience is possible.

Volunteer positions will be filled based on qualifications, and on a first-come, first serve basis.
